The Industrial Coating and Lining Application Specialist Level 1 engages in surface preparation and application of protective coatings and linings to steel and concrete surfaces of complex industrial structures. The Level I Application Specialist performs all duties under the supervision of a Level II Application Specialist. The Level I Application Specialist performs basic surface preparation and coating applications in a safe manner according to industry regulations.
